Our Programs Committee is made up of local volunteers who help staff with program evaluation and development and training and appreciation events. This work helps EAL deliver high quality programs!



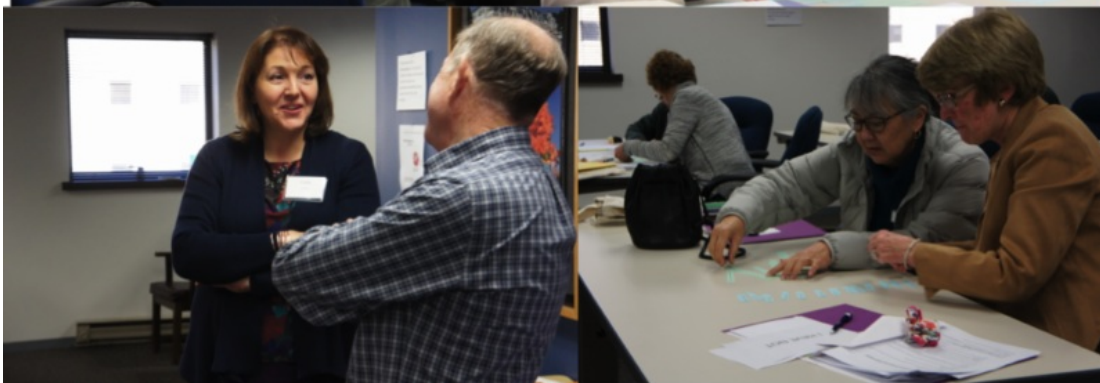
