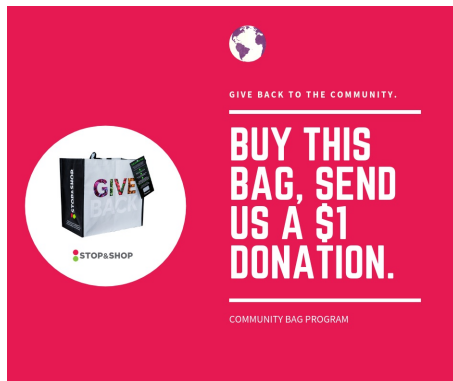
# EAL Volunteer Conference
