Eric leads our Career Access Lab Program, which currently has 3 cohorts of learners working to gain the skills they need for a successful U.S. job search. These learners held professional positions in their home countries in a variety of fields, including technology, health care and education. Eric's service will give them the skills, tools and confidence they need to realize their professional potential, and secure meaningful work here in the U.S. **Thank you Eric for your service!**

Our programs continue to run online, due to the tremendous commitment of our volunteers and staff. Recently the staff hosted a series of professional development trainings, including a *Zoom Academy*, to support our volunteers as they deliver high quality services in a remote environment. Programs Committee Members have also stepped up to help support our volunteers, hosting monthly Zoom networking events, during which volunteers can socialize and share best practices and advice to support each other.

In the coming weeks, we will match 10 EAL trained volunteers with learners from our waitlist for online tutoring. Spring Conversation Groups continue until May, as will our Beginner English class. Information on summer programs will be coming soon.
