English At Large Programs are held in public spaces across our service area.

All programs are offered free of charge to our learners.

One-to-One Tutoring

- Serves learners at all levels
- Provides individual instruction focused on learner goals
- Tutors and learners meet weekly in public spaces

Conversation Groups

- Serves intermediate to advanced learners
- Provides opportunities to build speaking and listening skills
- Groups meet weekly and enroll new learners
 3 times a year

Career Access Lab (CAL)

- Serves intermediate to advanced learners
- Provides instruction to build job search skills, resume review and interview practice
- Enrolls 2 cohorts each year; classes begin in January and March

Beginner English Class

- Serves low-level English learners
- Teaches survival English used in daily life
- Is hosted on campus at Tufts University
- New classes begin each fall


PARTNER PROGRAMS
